

To Ms. Pamela Stocking:

The Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is using Ellenville Public Library and Museum as the repository for site documents associated with EPA's investigation of the Ellenville Superfund site. The Remedial Investigation report is already at the library. A number of additional documents, including hard copies of the attached Proposed Plan, will be delivered to the library this evening from HDR, EPA's contractor. Please place these in the Ellenville repository.

I am attaching a pdf of EPA's Proposed Remedial Action Plan for the Ellenville site which discusses our preferred remedy. A 30-day public comment period opens Thursday, July 29th to solicit comment from the community. A public notice will be published in the Shawangunk Journal on Thursday, July 29th. The public notice will also be published in the MidHudson News which is an online paper only and can be found at the following website: <http://www.midhudsonnews.com/>.

**A public meeting will be held on August 18th at the Village Hall at 7:00 PM.** At this meeting, EPA will present the conclusions of its investigation, discuss the preferred remedy and receive any public comments.
